7:30 PM: Suzan Rudnicki called the Selectmen's meeting to order.

MINUTES: Isaac Raymond made a motion to accept the minutes of April 11, 2022, as written. Daniel Frye seconded. Five voted in favor.

TOWN MANAGER/ ROAD COMMISSIONER: Town Manager Kevin Howell went over with the board about the paving bids from the last meeting. Bids had come in little higher than expected. Kevin recommended using the remaining ARPA Funds to cover the cost, which is just over \$36k. Isaac Raymond made a motion to apply the remaining ARPA funds toward the payment projects. Jared Fitts seconded. Five in favor.

Kevin mentioned to the Selectmen he had spoken to Justin Wilson about filling the potholes around Town. Kevin let the Board know that Justin was well experienced and if there were no objections, he would like to hire him for the job. Board had no objections.

Town Manager informed the Board that the Carmel Snowmobile Club needed some fill. They were in the process of cutting new trails for 69/ Hermon since the new landowners had closed the old trail. Kevin said he had some leftover fill from the Ash Hill project and if the Selectmen had no objection, he would like to donate it to them. The board had no objections.

Kevin talked about sending a enforcement letter to 2 Hayward Road about junk on the property. Kevin mentioned he had gotten complaints from the neighbors.

WARRANT: Jared Fitts made a motion to accept the payroll warrant of April 18, 2022 in the amount of \$5,511.03. Daniel Frye seconded. Five voted in favor.

WARRANT: Jared Fitts made a motion to accept the payroll warrant of April 25 in the amount of \$6225.24 Daniel Frye seconded. Five voted in favor.
