

# Town of Carmel - Selectmen's Meeting

## June 13, 2022

**7:30 PM:** Suzan Rudnicki called the Selectmen's meeting to order.

**MINUTES:** Daniel Frye made a motion to accept the minutes of May 9, 2022 as written. Isaac Raymond seconded. Three voted in favor. Sue Rudnicki and Jared Fitts abstained as they were not present for that meeting.

**MINUTES:** Jared Fitts made a motion to accept the minutes of May 23, 2022 as written. Dan Frye seconded. Four voted in favor. Timothy Richardson, Jr. abstained as he was not present for that meeting.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

**Introduce Deputy Keeran:** Town Manager Kevin Howell stated Deputy Jordan Norton was promoted to a new position in the Sheriff's Department, and introduced Deputy Taylor Keeran as our new full-time deputy.

**Town Manager Vacation Request:** Kevin requested June 14<sup>th</sup> through June 17<sup>th</sup> as vacation time. Selectmen had no objections.

**Junkyard Complaint:** Kevin let the Board know he received a junkyard complaint for a property on Homestead Lane and said if Selectmen had no objections, he would start the enforcement process by writing a letter to the property owner. Selectmen had no objections.

**Street Flags:** The Town Manager said he would like to add a few flags in other areas of town, including by the Damascus Landing and the Rec Field. Selectmen approved.

**Road Striping:** There was discussion regarding striping town roads. Selectmen were in favor of Kevin looking into it.

**WARRANT:** Jared Fitts made a motion to accept the payroll warrant of May 31, 2022 in the amount of \$6,983.95. Dan Frye seconded. Five voted in favor.

**WARRANT:** Jared Fitts made a motion to accept the payroll warrant of June 6, 2022 in the amount of \$12,941.42. Dan Frye seconded. Dan Frye voted in favor.

**WARRANT:** Jared Fitts made a motion to accept the payroll warrant of June 13, 2022 in the amount of \$7,379.35. Dan Frye seconded. Dan Frye voted in favor.

**WARRANT:** Jared Fitts made a motion to accept the accounts payable warrant of June 13, 2022 in the amount of \$278,585.78. Tim Richardson seconded. Five voted in favor.
