7:30 PM: Suzan Rudnicki called the Selectmen's meeting to order.

MINUTES: Minutes were tabled because there were not enough voting members from last meeting.

RSU 87 Superintendent -Budget Presentation: There was discussion about the proposed RSU 87 budget for the 2022-2023 school year, with Carmel's portion increasing by 4% approximately \$102,527.

Sign Referendum Warrant-RSU 87 Budget: Isaac Raymond made a motion to sign the warrant for the RSU 87 Budget Referendum election on Tuesday, June 14, 2022. Daniel Frye seconded. Four voted in favor.

Quitclaim Deed for Samuel Connole: Isaac Raymond made a motion to sign a bill of sale to Samuel Connole for a single wide trailer. Dan Frye seconded. Four in favor.

2022-23 Snowplow Contract: Kevin let the board know Bobby from R & R Lumber was asking for an increase for the 2022-2023 season to \$228,900.00. It would be a one-year contract if the board agreed. Town Manager also mentioned he could put it out to bid if the board would like to get more estimates for the snowplowing. Suzan Rudnicki made a motion to sign the 2022-2023 Snowplow contract with R &R Lumber. Jared Fitts seconded. Four in favor.

New Business: Mr. Howell let the Board know that the MMA Grant for the new lights was approved for \$3000.00.

Kevin let the Selectmen know that there was a Grant for paving the Town landing on Damascus Road. He mentioned he had a site visit from the DEP official that agreed it would be a qualifying project. Kevin told the Selectmen he would be applying for it.

WARRANT: Jared Fitts made a motion to accept the payroll warrant of May 23, 2022 in the amount of \$6766.83. Daniel Frye seconded. Four voted in favor.
